5 Rudolf Rabl will never forget the evening of the 29th November 2019. Not only did he receive the trophy for the best Grüner Veltliner at the big international jubilee gala of the "International Wine & Spirit Competition" in London, but also the award for best white wine producer. Which Rudolf Rabl had not expected after the announcement that his winery had made it to the final selection.

10 “After last year's IWSC award for the world's best white wine, this is a confirmation of continuity. But also, for the fact that we are doing a good job and that we are on the right path with our aim to produce the best wines,” says Rudolf Rabl.
